**Spring Crossing Campus**

Spring, TX

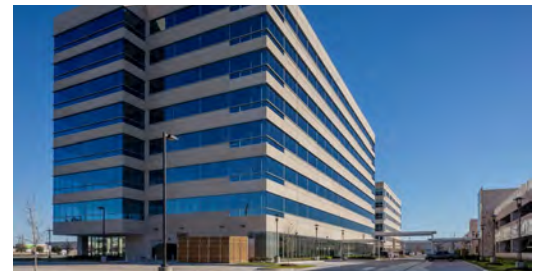
Phase I of this 3 building campus. The scope called for a 14-story, 380,000 sf office building built adjacent to the ExxonMobile campus near the Woodlands. Additionally there is a 7-story, 380,000 sf parking garage capable of holding 1,255 cars to service the building.



**Remington Square**

Houston, TX

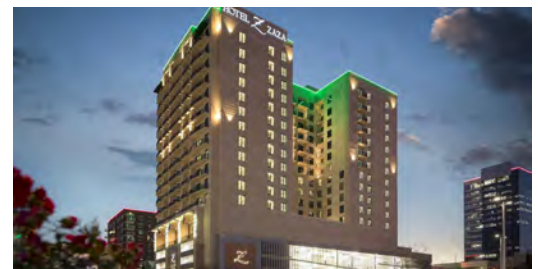
8-story, 200,000sf Class-A office building with a 3-level parking garage and surface parking located in northwest Houston. The project is registered LEED Core & Shell.



**Hotel Zaza - Memorial City Mall**

Houston, TX

17-story, 455,000 sf, boutique hotel and residential development by MetroNational, located near Bunker Hill Road and Interstate 10. Amenities include ballrooms, meeting space, restaurant and bar, fitness center, spa, and pool areas. A 285-space garage will accompany the hotel.

**ExxonMobile Office Campus**

Houston, TX

New corporate campus for ExxonMobile in the Springwoods Village area of Houston. The campus includes multiple low-rise office buildings, laboratory, conference and training centers, employee amenities all on a 385-acre wooded site.



**Halliburton Oak Park Campus**

Houston, TX

Projects on this campus included a commons building with cafeteria, fitness center, and daycare. A 335,000 sf parking garage for building 5 and a 442,000 sf parking garage for building 6.



**Memorial Hermann Healthcare System Services Tower - North**

Houston, TX

33-story medical building on the Memorial Hermann Healthcare Systems campus in the Memorial City area of Houston. The scope included 12-stories of hospital with 230 beds, 15-stories of medical office space, and 6 lantern levels. The structure also included a 2,028 care parking garage.



**455 Massachusetts Ave.**

Washington, DC

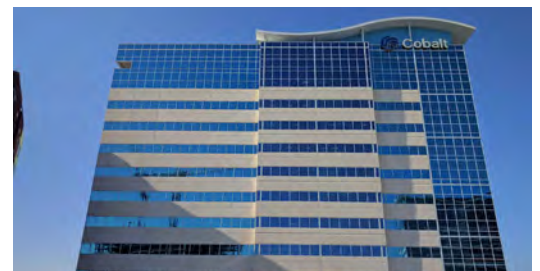
12-story, 259,000 sf office building near downtown Washington, DC. The building includes ground floor retail space and 4-levels, 85,500 sf, of below grade parking.



**Cobalt Building**

Houston, TX

14-story, 302,000 sf office building near the Memorial City area along Interstate 10 in Houston. The building was designed to be Certified LEED Silver.



**National Biodefense Analysis & Countermeasures Center (NBACC)**  
Fort Detrick, Frederick, MD

160,000 sf biocontainment laboratories on 3 levels with the capacity to conduct testing of high threat agents, research on threat agents, and bioforensics analysis.



**Granite Westchase 2**  
Houston, TX

14-story, 335,000-sf office building with an 8-level precast parking garage. Granite Westchase was the first building in Houston to be certified under the LEED® Core and Shell program and also the first Gold rated LEED building in the city.



**7900 Fannin Medical Office Building & Parking Garage**  
Houston, TX

4-story, 180,000 sf medical office building near NRG Stadium in Houston. The building also includes a 4-story 700-car parking garage dedicated to doctors, staff, and patients.



**Microsoft - Sierra VI**  
Las Colinas, TX

New building and garage at the corporate campus for Microsoft in Las Colinas. The structures include a 4-story, 233,000 sf office building and 4-level, 360,000 sf parking garage.



**Sugar Land Town Square**  
Houston, TX

Buildings and structures throughout the Sugar Land Town Square area. The scope of the project included retail, office, hotel, and residential space all totaling to 1.13 Million sf.
