3333 Allen Parkway

Houston, TX

30-story, 520,000 sf residential tower along Allen Parkway in Houston. The tower also includes a 520-car parking garage.



BMC Software

New BMC Software campus including a 21-story, 20-story, and 9-story buildings totaling 1.6 Million sf. He also worked on a 6-story visitors center and four 6-level parking garages that total 1.7 Million sf.



George Bush Intercontinental Airport Terminal E

Houston, TX

New construction of Terminal E at the George Bush Intercontinental Airport in Houston. The scope was for the design of a brand new 1 Million sf terminal that included retail space, facilities and storage, and public facilities.

Projects for this Orlando Resort Company included three of the vacation resorts. The Lodge design is a 1,300 room resort. Spring Resort is a 1.25 Million sf, 1,920 hotel room and conference center. New 5-story, 220,000 sf building in the Energy Corridor on Interstate 10 in Houston. The scope included the design of the new building and garage.

New 10-story, 944,000 sf building on the HBU campus. The building acts as the Residence Life building for students attending the University.



Hobby Center for the Performing Arts

Houston, TX

New the Hobby Center for the Performing Arts building in Houston. The scope included two performance halls with 2,700 and 500 seats and a 241,000 sf, 800 car parking garage.



Memorial Hermann Healthcare System Services Tower - North Houston, TX

33-story medical building on the Memorial Hermann Healthcare Systems campus in the Memorial City area of Houston. The scope included 12-stories of hospital with 230 beds, 15-stories of medical office space, and 6 lantern levels. The structure also included a 2,028 care parking garage.





Square 516 Office Center

Washington, DC

12-story, 350,000 sf office building near downtown Washington, DC. The building includes ground floor retail space and 4-levels of below grade parking.



Sysco Headquarters Campus

Houston, TX

New buildings on the Sysco Headquarters Campus in Houston. The scope included a 12-story, 327,000 sf office building, 8-story, 214,00 sf office building, and a 343,000 sf parking garage.



Texas A&M University

College Station, TX

Projects on this campus included several buildings on the Texas A&M University campus in College Station. He worked on the 4-story, 61,000 sf E.L. Wehner & Cox Business School building and a 7-level, 1.2 Million sf, parking garage capable of holding 3,800 cars.
